Amendment to the Agreement
Between
the United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific and the World
Trade Organization
Regarding a Joint Training Programme for Developing Countries

THIS AMENDMENT is made between the United Nations Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (hereinafter referred to as "ESCAP") and the World Trade Organization (hereinafter referred to as "WTO").

WHEREAS WTO and ESCAP entered into the Agreement Regarding a Joint Training Programme for Developing Countries which entered into force on 8 July 2004 (the "Agreement"),

NOW THEREFORE, WTO and ESCAP hereby agree as follows:

ARTICLE 1
Extension

The Parties hereby agree to continue to cooperate in trade-related technical assistance to developing countries for their economic and social development under the same terms and conditions as set forth in the Agreement, subject to availability of funds, and agree to extend the duration of the Agreement.

ARTICLE 2
Amendments


The Parties hereby agree that Article 11 of the Agreement shall be amended and restated as follows:

Entry into force


This Agreement will enter into force on the date of its signature by both Parties and will expire on 31 December 2011."
